- Go to the last row of warehouses on the right before you get to Nolensville Rd.

From I-440:

- Take the Nolensville Rd exit headed south. Go 2 miles.
- Turn right on Allied Drive (at Whitt's Barbeque).
- Immediately turn left into the first row of warehouses.

From I-24:

- Take the Brilley Parkway West exit (Thompson Lane)
- Turn left on Nolensville Road.
- Turn right onto Allied Drive (at Whitt's Barbeque).
- Immediately turn left into the first row of warehouses.

JUMP HEIGHTS

All classes will be run in **descending jump height order** beginning with the highest jump height entered in each class (except to accommodate handlers with multiple entries). **Obedience High Jump Height is required for all entries** in classes with jumps in the trials. **Rally Jump Height** is required for Advanced and Excellent classes.

MOVE UP INFORMATION:

Move ups in Obedience and Rally will be accepted in writing only. Move ups may be approved provided the next level class (i.e. Novice to Open) and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit. All move ups must be submitted at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Movement between an “A” and “B” class at the same level is not considered a move up and is not allowed after close of entries. There are no move ups between optional titling classes and regular classes (i.e.: no movement from Novice to Graduate Novice).

◆◆ The Trial Site will be available to exhibitors for set-up after 4:00 p.m. CST on Friday, March 30, 2012. Do NOT crate in front of fire extinguishers.

- Obedience trial entry fees include a 50¢ AKC first entry Recording Fee and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. Rally trial entry fees include a \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee.
- Make checks payable to NDTC. Please typewrite or print all information required on entry forms.
- Incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable and cannot be entered in the show. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Email changes must be made to the Secretary at: junej@esarch.com. **Changes by phone are NOT acceptable.**
- Please note to waive signature if sending by express or overnight mail. Postdated or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A fee of \$30 will be charged for all returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in future entries being accepted on a cash-only basis.
- E-mail, fax, telephone, and conditional entries without the AKC agreement on the back are NOT acceptable. Incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trials. Entries will not be accepted without fees and signatures.
- Entries close at the office of the Secretary at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 11, 2012.
- The club holding this event has the right to refuse entries for cause which it deems sufficient.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Nashville Dog Training Club, its volunteers, their agents, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- NDTC reserves the right to rescue any dog that may be in distress in a vehicle and be held harmless for damage to the vehicle.

- All dogs must be on leash except when in ring.
- Trophies/Awards not particular to a specific class will only be awarded after all scores have been turned in to the Trial Secretary. No trophies/awards will be mailed. **The club reserves the right to offer a trophy of equal or greater value.**

Verbal corrections, gentle guidance and toys will be permitted. Only buckle collars, chain/leather/fabric slip or martingale collars are allowed. No food will be permitted in the rings.

Group sits and downs are included at no additional charge for dogs signed up for Match Novice or Open ring time. Group exercises will be conducted at appropriate intervals at the club's discretion.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
