Club members who volunteer at least 10 hours per year may take classes for half price and rent ring time for half price. Members who commit to teach two classes in a year may attend unlimited classes in that year for free and may also use the building for free throughout the year. Members who serve on the board of directors receive two years of benefit for each year of service.

As a volunteer organization, the club is always in need of people to teach classes, serve as ring stewards at matches and obedience trials, perform any number of duties for our trials, distribute marketing brochures, help with building maintenance and trash removal, answer the phone lines and field questions, write for and edit our newsletter, and represent the club at public events, to name just a few of the many functions that must be performed in order to fulfill our goals. Many of these functions do not require specific dog-training knowledge or experience. There is a suitable job for any person wishing to support the club.

I understand that, even when handled with care, other dogs may be difficult to control and may cause injury to my dog, my guests, or me.
