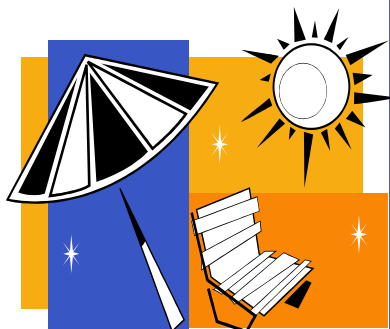

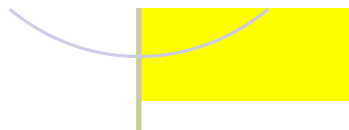

## Exciting Plans for the 2005 Obedience Trial

Would you like to be able to go to a first class obedience trial for 4-days in air-conditioned comfort during the summer on your door-step? Then mark your calendar in June 2005 for the NDTC trial! A proposal to hold a separate 2005 trial at the Tennessee Fairgrounds was submitted to the Board at the June meeting and unanimously approved. The trial will be in the Creative Arts Building which holds 4 rings comfortably in the center and has plenty of room for spectators, vendors and a separate cooled crating area. The tentative date for the 2005 event is June 9 – 12, 2005.

At the April Club meeting the membership present voted to move forward with the 2004 combined agility and obedience event since much work and planning had been done. We thank all those involved in both of the trial committees and look forward to a great event.

Members were unanimous in their support of the combined event but also raised some very valid concerns. First, that we would not have the people to run both events at the same time and second, that combining the events makes it hard, if not impractical, for Club members working at the trial(s) to show their dogs at both events all four days. The plan for the 2005 trial addresses these concerns for our membership and sets the stage for NDTC to maintain its reputation for first-class events and hospitality.

## Club Member Brags

- Bev Watson-Sanders and her English Springer Spaniel, Fair Wind's Firkin CGC TD, passed their TD test at the Dayton Dog Training Club's TD/TDX test on April 13, 2003 under judges Susan Eldred and Stephen Ripley. Their track was 450 yards long, 42 minutes old, and they ran it in seven minutes.
- Debbie Cutter's Scottish Deerhound, Ch. Highlander Annwn O'Jubalhil VCD2 is the first Scottish Deerhound to earn the VCD2 title. She completed this by earning her OAJ at the Clarksville agility trial. This is our second VCD2 dog here at NDTC!!!!
- Debbie Cutter—Ariel (Skyhigh Citabria O'Jubalhil JC TD NA NAJ FCh) earned an NA and a NAJ leg at Clarksville and then went on to earn the NA title at the Huntsville Agility Trial.
- Then, to top off Debbie Cutter's news, , at the Scottish Deerhound National Specialty in Elizabethtown, KY (May 6-11), Ariel finished her NAJ under judge Jane Mohr, earned her first CD leg and went High in Trial under judge Richard Mullen, placed fourth in the AKC coursing trial Open stake, placed third in the ASFA (American Sighthound Field Assoc.) coursing trial FCh Stake, and went Best of Breed in the LGRA (Large Gazehound Racing Assoc.) race meet. She now needs only one more point for her GRC (Gazehound Racing Champion) title.
- But wait, I forgot one more brag from Debbie— Ch. Kyleakin Cardinal at Skyhigh UD TD (Lacey) placed fourth of twelve in the Veteran Bitch class and was runner up in the treat toss Contest!

Gosh, am I done with Debbie Cutter????????? I believe I am. What a busy month she has had!!!

- Judy Hackett's Border Collie Ch VX Shoreland's Doublestuff Magee VCD2 MX OAJ HRD1d HTD1s PT TT GCG, Magee, earned his MX in Priceville, AL on May 18th with a first place win. All other nine legs were won with first, second, or third place wins.
- Well, well, look what came in later! Debbie Cutter's Scottish Deerhound, (Ariel), Skyhigh Citabria O'Jubalhil JC TD NA NAJ FCh, finished her GRC (Gazehound Racing Champion) Title on May 26 at the Borzoi Club of Greater Atlanta's LGRA (Large Gazehound Racing Assoc.) meet in Cartersville, GA. Gosh, Debbie, your hounds are going to have a powwow without you to decide what you owe them after all the success they have had this spring.
- Holly Waldrop' Dalmation, Baxter, finished his OA with a 4th place and swept through his AXJ in three straight days with two 3rd places and a second place at the HOTC agility trial in Priceville, AL, on May 2-4. Also, her other dog, Boo, double-Qed two days in Novice Standard and Jumpers earning her first two NA legs (one 1st place and one 2nd place) and NAJ (both 1st places).
- Lisa Schmidt's smmoth collie puppy, Julip's Genuine Risk, aka Claire, went to her first show in Edinburg, In. and took WB for a 5 point major at the Indiana Collie Specialty at 6 months and 4 days old. Claire also took a 4 point major on Sunday, May 25 at the Cincinnati Kennel Club show under Judge Tommy Coen. She was WB for 4 pts., and BOW to boot. This makes Claire's second major at 6 months 2 weeks old.
- Lynda Condurelis' Sheltie, Figures Dixie Darlin UD (Chloe) earned two UDX legs on March 8 & 9 at the Indian River dog Training Club in Melbourne, FL. The first day's scores were UDX leg 193 and Open B leg 190. In her first agility trial on March 9th in Palmetto, FL Chloe took a 2nd place in 12" Novice JWW and won 1st place in Novice Standard with a clean run ten seconds under time. Chloe and Lynda also have won some Open B and Utility B qualifying ribbons, but not on the same day.
