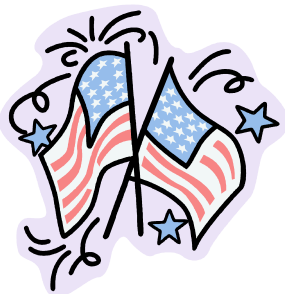

Judging begins for Novice and Utility at 8:00 a.m. Open will start after the first 10 Novice dogs have completed their group exercises.

Pup Scouts has generously agreed to let us use their building for this show & go, so that we can have a match in air conditioned comfort.

Since we will only have two rings, Novice and Open will alternate every 10 dogs, until Utility is finished. At that point we will run Open in one ring and Novice in the other.

Directions

From I-65 north-bound or south-bound

Take exit 79 "Armory Drive". When you exit you can go only one way on Armory Drive. Stay on Armory Drive. There is a 4-way stop at Sidco. A long block beyond the 4-way stop Armory Drive turns left and parallels the railroad tracks. Pup Scouts is approximately .4 mile after the left turn, it is the next to the last building on your left.

From I-40 east-bound

Take exit 206 "I-440 East Knoxville". Take I-440 to exit 5 "I-65 South Huntsville" stay in the right lane. Take I-65 to exit 79 "Armory Drive". When you exit you can go only one way on Armory Drive. Stay on Armory Drive. There is a 4-way stop at Sidco. A long block beyond the 4-way stop Armory Drive turns left and parallels the railroad tracks. Pup Scouts is approximately .4 mile after the left turn, it is the next to the last building on your left .

OR

Take exit 210 A "I-65 South Huntsville". Take I-65 South to exit 79 "Armory Drive". When you exit you can go only one way on Armory Drive. Stay on Armory Drive. There is a 4-way stop at Sidco. A long block beyond the 4-way stop Armory Drive turns left and parallels the railroad tracks. Pup Scouts is approximately .4 mile after the left turn, it is the next to the last building on your left.

From I-24 east-bound

Take exit 54 "Briley Parkway State Route 155". At the end of the exit ramp merge right onto Briley Parkway. Go through 3 traffic lights, the third one is Nolensville Pike. Get in the left lane, go through the Hicks-Ellis Tunnel (railroad overpass). Turn left on Foster Creighton, the first street after the tunnel. Cameron Motors is on your left, El Mariachi Restaurant is on your right. Go one block on Foster Creighton, turn left on to Armory Drive, Pup Scouts is the second building on the right.

From I-24 west-bound

Take exit 54 "Briley Parkway, State Route 155 West". Turn left at the light at the end of the exit ramp. Go through 4 traffic lights, the fourth one is Nolensville Pike. Get in the left lane, go through the Hicks-Ellis Tunnel (railroad overpass). Turn left on Foster Creighton, the first street after the tunnel. Cameron Motors is on your left, El Mariachi Restaurant is on your right. Go one block on Foster Creighton, turn left on to Armory Drive, Pup Scouts is the third building on the right.

Club Member Brags

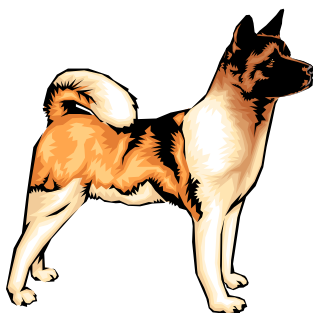
