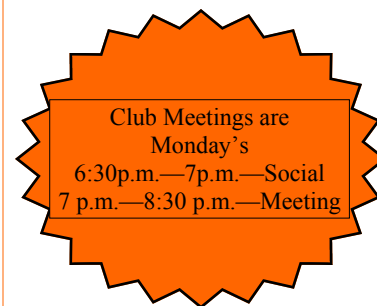

- Marina Caro's Whippet, Vesta, earned a 5 point MAJOR in Hanover, PA at an AKC lure coursing trial over the Labor Day weekend. She also earned her SC title as well. She only needs 8 points and one major to earn her AKC Field Champion title.
- Wendy Boehme's, Swiss Stars Urban Cowboy TD RN CGC "Houston" Finished Rally Novice title at Murfreesboro Obedience trial July 16th Was inners Dog Saturday 7/30 for a 3 point major and again Sunday 7/31 for 2 points in Greenville, SC. Houston finished his championship with a three point major in Atlanta on 8/26/05. Also, Houston finished his Novice Agility Preferred title at the NDTC trial on October 2, 2005 and picked up 2 of the 3 legs towards his Novice Jumpers Preferred title during the weekend. Houston is having a good year!!
- Connie Womack's Keeper - Starwood's Autumn Keepsake, AX,AXJ, earned his breed Championship at the Atlanta Cluster Shows. On September 23, Keeper won a 4 point major taking Winners Dog and on September 24, he won a second 4 point major taking Winners Dog to finish his title. At NDTC Keeper took fourth place in Excellent Standard and a Double Q on Friday and another Double Q on Saturday in Standard and Jumpers.
- Connie Womack's Katie took first place in Open Standard on Friday at the NDTC trial.
- Cheryl Brown's youngest Papillon, Jackson (a.k.a. Loteki Civil Liberties) won Winners Dog, Best of Winners, and Best of Breed (over two Champions) at the Chattanooga Kennel Club show on September 17. Jackson is barely 1 year old and now has both of his majors and 9 points towards his Championship!
- Jo-Anne Bachorowski's PWD,Tuck left for the Portuguese Water Dog National Specialty as De Leao's Seaspray, CD NAJ. And he came home as De Leao's Seaspray, CD NA NAJ RN AWD. The AWD is his Apprentice Water Dog title, which he earned at his very first water trial -- a huge accomplishment. His Novice Standard agility title has been two years (!) in the making, but he finished it in style with a clean run and 4th place. We missed placing in Rally Novice B by one point. And we came in 15th out of 62 teams in the Superdog competition (open to teams entered in 3 or more events). What a fantastic week my sweet boy gave me!
- Debbie Cutter's Kit (Skyhigh Spitfire O'Jubalhil CDX SC NA NAJ FCh GRC) finished her CDX in Atlanta on September 3
- Debbie Cutter's (Ch. Skyhigh Citabria O'Jubalhil VCD2 SC AX AXJ FCh GRC) finished her breed championship in Atlanta on Sept. 24. Ariel also earned her fifth MXJ leg at the Nashville agility trial.

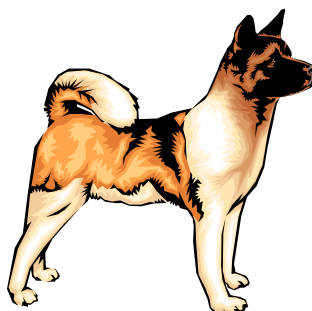
This is a great way to rack up those 10 volunteer hours towards your membership and discounted classes. You don't have to be an experienced handler or currently showing to help steward at our trial.
