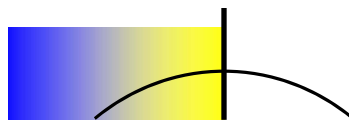

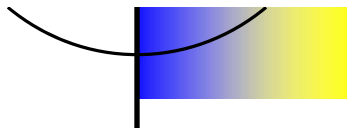

Wilson County 4-H Dog Project Update

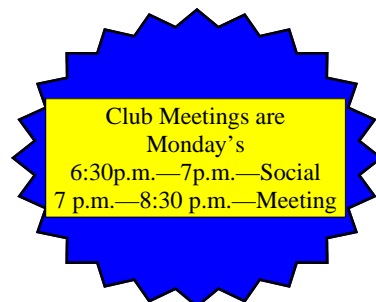

Club Member Brags

- Cheryl Geer (formerly Cheryl Brown) reports that her summer in the Northeast has resulted in a new Champion!!! Her Papillon, Jackson (aka Ch. Loteki Civil Liberties CGC), arrived in Vermont with 9 points (2 majors won in Tennessee). Jackson won 4 out of 6 shows in Massachusetts. He finished his championship on July 8 in West Springfield, Massachusetts with a total of 17 points and 3 major wins.
- Abby Vorhaus (my daughter) earned 2 legs in Novice Rally in Huntsville as a very young Junior Handler with her lab Carolina.
- Connie McGhee's Labrador Retriever, McGhee's Dandy Lion, CGC (Angus) earned his first leg in Rally Novice A on August 5th at Huntsville's Obedience Trial. This was both Connie's and Angus' first trial. It was also the day after Angus' 2nd birthday - what a great way to celebrate!
- Claudia Dickerson and her Belgian Tervuren Anna (KO Trillium Annapurna HSAs NA NAJ) have added three titles this year, a CD, finishing at the Huntsville obedience trial August 7, and their first two AHBA herding titles, HRDI and HTDI. The herding titles were earned with a first place and two fourth places in Elizabethtown, KY, June 17 and 18.
- Jo-Anne Bachorowski's Portuguese Water Dog, De Leao's Sun of an Itch (aka Stitch) got her first two CD legs at the Murfreesboro trials with scores of 198 and 189.
- Holly Waldrop's Dalmation Creed (Snow Hill Phoenix Believe In Me, NA, NAJ) earned two Open standard legs - placing 4th on Saturday and 1st on Sunday - to finish his Open Agility title at the Dayton Dog Training Club's obedience trial July 29-30, all 3 days BEFORE his 2nd birthday!
- Holly Waldrop's Baxter (K-Max Pure Poetry, CD, RN, MX, MXJ) earned his first Rally Advanced leg with a score of 95 at the Murfreesboro Obedience Training Club's rally trial on July 16.
- Denise McClure's Berner, CH Brighteye Shooting Star VCD2 TDX RA (Hayley) earned her CDX title in obedience on August 5 in Huntsville, AL. Hayley earned this last leg with a first place win and a score of 193. Earning her CDX obedience title also give Hayley all the titles she needed to earn the designation of VCD2. To be a VCD2 dog, one must earn a CDX in obedience, a TD in tracking, and an OA and OAJ in agility.
- Betty Stephenson's was busy at the Scottish Deerhound National specialty in Frankenmuth, MI, in May: Linnet (now Ch. Kyleakin Linnet CDX SC FCh VC) came in fourth in LGRA (Large Gazehound Racing Assoc.), won her AKC Open Field coursing class for a five point coursing major, came in third in the ASFA Field Champions class, and won third in the Field Trial Bitches conformation class to win All-Around-Hound for 2006! Aycha (Ch Kyleakin Skyrin' Aycha UD) won the Veteran's obedience class with a 194 (and that included a no Front!) and the Veteran Bitches over 9 years old conformation class! Tally (Ch Utkinton Fitzhugh Talon JC) won the Field Trial Dogs class and went on to an Award of Merit! Kyleakin Condor took third in a big 12-18 month Dog class (Winner's Dog came from that class)!

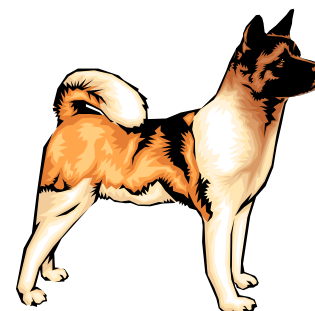

- Faye Head's Whippet, Arlen's Red Letter Day, known as Cate, earned her Rally Novice (RN) title on Saturday, August 12th at the GLTC trial.
- Faye Head's West Highland White Terrier, Daphne, known as CH. Wyne-croft Winning Ticket, NA, AXP, NAJ, AJP, earned her Rally Novice (RN) title on Saturday, August 5, at the HOTC Obedience and Rally Trial.
