Don't forget, we will be having an obedience C match the Friday evening before the trials (November 18). I need several folks to help man the rings and take money for this. It will be timed run-throughs, not a judged event, so only 1-2 people per ring. The times of the match will be 5-8 pm. If you can help, please let me know.
